The P&C works in collaboration with our Principal Mr. Sean Moran and the teaching staff in fostering a positive learning environment with a strong sense of community spirit: an environment where our children are provided the tools to thrive and grow.

This can only be accomplished by our highly active and inclusive parent community, which comes together to coordinate fun, social fundraising activities. Each year we aim to raise over \$150,000 to help provide services and facilities the school would not otherwise have.

Recent / Future P&C Funded Programs

- Funding for the school to employ staff to support middle band students with reading and numeracy
- Funding for the rolling upgrade of classroom smart-board and digital equipment
- New junior playground upgrade (*commencing early 2020*)
- Laptops for Years 5 & 6 students (*ongoing maintenance & upgrades*)
- Williams Building air-conditioning (top floor) / School hall fans (*past funding*)
- \$250,000 major landscaping project outdoor classrooms & retractable cricket nets
- Water stations within the school to reduce plastic waste (*past funding*)
