Your P&C

The P&C works in collaboration with our Principal Mr Sean Moran and the teaching staff in fostering a positive learning environment with a strong sense for inquisitive expression: an environment where our children are provided with the tools to thrive and grow.

We can only accomplish this by having a highly active and inclusive parent community that collaborate to deliver enjoyable and social, and community focused fundraising activities. Each year, the P&C aims to raise over \$150,000 to provide educational support and facility upgrades the school would not otherwise have.

Being a member of the P&C provides you with the platform to guide these significant initiatives.

Recent / Future P&C Funded Programs

- Funding of a new COLA shade structure over the basketball courts (commencing late 2021)
- Funding to employ teaching staff to support middle band students with reading and numeracy
- \$140,00 for new junior playground upgrade
- Laptops for Years 5 & 6 students (*ongoing maintenance & upgrades*)
- Williams Building air-conditioning (top floor) / School hall fans (*past funding*)
- \$250,000 major landscaping project outdoor classrooms & retractable cricket nets
